F.I.S.L.Y. President's word

45 years Fisly 1962 - 2007

On the eve of the 44th European Championships, it's an honour to present you the 16th edition of Fisly News. In this edition I will focus on three main topics: communication, the new constitution of FISLY and the next EC and WC.

This newsletter is beside our website one of our communication tools. But we have to improve it and for this reason we need your support. For each edition it is difficult to obtain news from the different federations and clubs all over the world. By this way we thank all sailors and people who assume responsibility for their federation or club to contribute to these newsletters. But do not wait till the last moment to send your articles about major land sailing events : do it when you have news to share with other sailors. When we have sufficient content an extra edition can even be considered every 6 months to publish on our website. The printed version will be published once a year. Also a limited number of pictures can be joined in each article.

2007 will be a milestone in the history of our international federation. Founded 45 years ago on august 23 1963 at Lytham St. Annes by representatives of Belgium (R. Nyssens), England (R. Dawson), France (J. Gimel) and Germany F. Gerlach), FISLY played a key role in the development of land yachting in and out of Europe.

The main achievements are the development of consistent racing rules, land yacht classes and the promotion of international land yacht events such as European Championships since 1963 and World Championships since 2002 (USA), 2004 (G), 2006 (France), 2008 (Argentina). Fisly decided in 1990 to organise a world championship every 2 years in Europe and every 6 years in another continent. In 2002 for the first time in the history of land yachting world championships have been organised in USA followed by the WC 2004 in Germany and 2006 in France.

Argentina has been appointed for the WC 2008. This is a new milestone in the history of our sport.

FISLY is conscious of the fact that it requires an exceptional effort of European sailors to go overseas but Europeans have to consider that for sailors from North and South America, Australia and New Zealand, Africa and in the future Asia (India) it is also a major investment to participate in world championships on European beaches. FISLY is convinced that in the long term it will contribute to the world wide expansion of our sport. The final goal is to give access to the Olympic games, maybe it is a dream but why not....? Maybe the formula of championships has to be adapted in the future after evaluation.

To improve the governance of FISLY in favour of the development of land yachting, a new constitution for FISLY has been edited and finally approved in Le Touquet (France) after 4 years of discussion by the council and general assembly. The founding act has been drawled by the notary on 25th of January 2007 in Leuven (Belgium). By this day FISLY is recognised as an International non profit Association (by Belgian law) by Royal Act on proposal of the Belgian Minister of Justice on 23rd of March 2007 and this has been published in the Belgian State Journal. Since the foundation of Fisly 44 years ago, land yachting is today an international sport. There are clubs and national federations in Europe, North America, South America, New Zealand, Australia and also in Africa (Tunisia, and Djibouti). India is also interested in our sport.

This evolution has an impact on the new constitution: there are full members, associated members and corresponding members. All those members have a voting right in the GA, max. 3 votes for full members till min. 1 vote for the corresponding members.

The constitution introduces also the concept of regions in the world as for example

Europe, America, Australia and New Zealand... The goal to create regions is to promote closer relationships and activities within the region. Corresponding members have also the right to attend to the GA. In the Fisly council one counsellor can be nominated by the associated members.

There is also a development in the classes: beside the 4 active land yacht classes we have cl 7 (speed sail), cl 8 (kite buggy) and small land yachts as Manta and Blokart. Some classes have disappeared in the competition (cl 1).

In February 2008 we have the 11th "Campeonato Mundial de Carrovelismo" in Patagonia – Argentina. This is a new milestone for land yachting. This championship is a key event for the promotion of our sport in Argentina and South America. For this reason Fisly decided not to organise an European championship in 2008 for cl 2, 3, Std, 5 and Promo. There will be an European championship for cl 8 in the Netherlands. In 2009 a 45th European Championship will be organised in Germany (St. Peter Ording) and in 2010 there is the 12th World Championship in Belgium (De Panne).

Only a few days ago, the European championship for class 8 has been sailed on the beach of Pembrey (UK).

Today we are at the eve of the 44th European Championship in Hoylake (UK). It is the first time that Wirral Sand Yacht Club organises a European championship. The former EC in UK has been organised 10 years ago in Lytham St. Annes. We are aware that for the Wirral Sand Yacht Club it has been a big engagement to achieve this project. It is due to a team with very motivated members that we have the opportunity to sail on the special beach of Hoylake. Thanks to all who have made it possible. We are convinced that this championship will contribute to the promotion of our sport in UK.

We want to thank the organisers for their effort and their hospitality, but also the regional government and the participating town for the financial and logistic support. Finally we thank the commercial sponsors for their efforts, because without them such an event cannot be organised.

Anyhow, most important are the land sailors. We hope you enjoy a sportive championship and we wish that the best of you will win in the spirit of the Olympic idea. Fair winds !

Our main race of the season will take place on the weekend of the 20. and 21. october 2007.


